### WHERE DO WE STAND

1. Monthly Budget \$23,385. 2017 YTD Budget \$36,770.
2. February 2017 general fund offering \$14,786; YTD General fund offering: \$29,804.
3. February offerings were 58.16% below budget. YTD offerings 36.28% below budget.
4. Unrestricted cash on hand as of February 28<sup>th</sup> \$53,666: (Jan 2017 balance; \$59,726).
5. Account 5115 CBFNC Mission Resource Plan (our church 10% tithe) paid for February.
6. Designated fund offering for February were \$3,182. Designated fund balance for Feb 28<sup>th</sup> was \$120,656.

Martha's Kitchen offers a warm, free meal to members of our community twice a week. Currently, our volunteer roster is filled for this ministry, but prayers are always welcome.

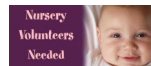
### Martha's Kitchen Food Lion Pick Up
