Because every Wednesday we have the BEST time fellowshiping around the table, sharing prayer requests, studying God’s Word and talking about HOW His Word applies to our lives.

One of our recent Wednesday Night Bible Studies involved digging in to the principles of God’s Word about FAITH. Like many of the foundational concepts of our Life in Christ, the word faith is often misused and misunderstood! **Hebrews 11:1** says that faith is “the substance of things hoped for and the evidence of things not seen”. BUT – what does that mean?!?!

In the world’s way of thinking, hope typically refers to something that “might” happen. But for the Christian, hope includes a period of waiting before the actual revelation of what God has promised occurs.... And God’s promises are ALWAYS a sure thing! Faith becomes reality as we move our hopes in line with the desires of God. Then, it’s not a matter of “if” but “when”.

Is there substance in what you are hoping for and evidence of what you can’t see? Often REAL faith requires a period of waiting and adjustment. That is, we must sometimes wait on God to complete a process where He is at work so that the reality of our faith becomes tangible. And our human perspective often requires adjustment so that our thoughts and emotions come in line with God’s divine plan and perspective.

The Heroes of our Faith who we read about in scripture were just ordinary people who had one thing in common – their persevering, unwavering, bound and determined FAITH in God. They each had a tenacious dependence on God and were not about to be swayed by anything that attempted to point them in a direction other than HIS direction.

I pray for that kind of Faith and I pray that you will have that kind of faith ... I pray that we might be a Church that demonstrates that kind of persevering, unwavering, bound and determined Faith so that the GOSPEL flows freely to our world in all that we do!
