WHERE DO WE STAND

1. Monthly Budget \$23,385. 2017 YTD Budget \$70,155.
2. March 2017 general fund offering \$16,428; YTD General Fund offering: \$46,232.
3. March offerings were 42.35% below budget. YTD offerings 34% below budget.
4. Unrestricted cash on hand as of March 31st \$48,809: (Feb 2017 balance; \$53,666).
5. Account 5115 CBFNC Mission Resource Plan (our church 10% tithe) paid for March.
6. Designated fund offering for March were \$1,257. Designated fund balance for March 31st was \$111,953.

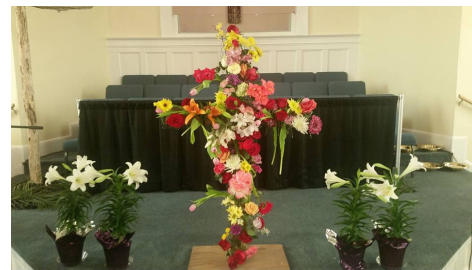


All youth are invited!!

Long Range Planning Committee

Your Long-Range Planning Committee will be working to develop Teams that will focus on each of the Five Ministry Areas of our Church. If you have a special passion to work on creating Ministries of Excellence in one of the following areas, please let Pastor Hal know so that he can connect you to the Team Leaders for that Area...

1. *Worship Ministry*

Is any Church program or event which has an end goal of engaging individuals and our Church Family in experiences of Worship. For example: In our Sunday morning Worship Services, it is our primary focus to bring supreme honor and exaltation to God through Jesus Christ, while desiring the presence and power of the Holy Spirit in our lives. Worship is foundational in all our experiences as Christ-Followers because it represents our humble, desperate need to express reverence and adoration for our Heavenly Father.

2. *Discipleship Ministry*

Is any Church program or event which has an end goal of providing knowledge, insight and understanding related to personal learning and growth as a Follower of Christ. For example: Sunday School, VBS, Youth Group, Small Group, etc., are all examples of Discipleship Ministry. These are programs where Disciples of Christ are developed through specific curriculum and/or learning activities.

3. *Evangelism Ministry*

Is any Church program or event which has an end goal of intentionally sharing the clear, concise Gospel message with our world. For example: an organized, intentional effort to hand out tracts and talk to people about the love of Jesus on the Boardwalk is Evangelism Ministry. We are called as Disciples of Christ to “go into all the World” and share the Gospel. (Matthew 28:18-20)

4. *Fellowship Ministry*

Is any Church program or event which has an end goal of deepening our relationships with one another in the Body of Christ through specific programs and events focused on our Fellowship together. For example: our Wednesday night dinners at church is part of our Fellowship Ministry because it provides an opportunity which allows our church family and visitors to get to know one another on a deeper, more intimate and personal basis as we experience the love of Christ together and for each other.

5. *Helping Ministry*

Is any Church program or event which has an end goal of providing for the physical needs of individuals in our church and community. For example: Martha’s Kitchen is an example of a Helping Ministry. Another Helping Ministry would be providing financial assistance from a Church benevolence fund for a Church Family that has fallen on hard times. These are opportunities to meet specific physical needs of individuals in our community and Church through Christian love and compassion.
