WHERE DO WE STAND

1. Monthly budget \$23,750.
2. November 2014 general fund offerings \$23,637. YTD offerings are \$246,996.
3. 2014 YTD general fund budget \$285,007.
4. YTD Offerings compared to budget to date are \$14,260 under budgeted amount.
5. Unrestricted cash on hand as of November 30 was \$72,675.

Our general fund offerings were below the monthly budgeted amount by \$113.83 for the month of November. We are \$14,260 **UNDER** budgeted revenue through November. We collected \$16,240 in designated funds for the month.

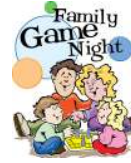
