Do You Know What You Believe?

Does it really matter what you believe? The Bible suggests that God wants His followers to know what we believe, why we believe it, and be able to share it with others. God wants us to live by a biblical worldview. Our church subscribes to the 1963 *Baptist Faith and Message*, which summarizes 18 major doctrines. To assist you in learning and abiding by a biblical worldview, over the next several months I will highlight various sections of our doctrinal statement. Last month we looked at our beliefs on Man and Salvation. This month we will highlight the doctrines of GOD'S PURPOSE OF GRACE and THE CHURCH.

GOD'S PURPOSE OF GRACE: Election is the gracious purpose of God, according to which He regenerates, sanctifies, and glorifies sinners. It is consistent with the free agency of man, and comprehends all the means in connection with the end. It is a glorious display of Gods sovereign goodness, and is infinitely wise, holy, and unchangeable. It excludes boasting and promotes humility. All true believers endure to the end. Those whom God has accepted in Christ, and sanctified by His Spirit, will never fall away from the state of grace, but shall persevere to the end. Believers may fall into sin through neglect and temptation, whereby they grieve the Spirit, impair their graces and comforts, bring reproach on the cause of Christ, and temporal judgments on themselves, yet they shall be kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation.

Its Scriptural officers are pastors and deacons. The New Testament speaks also of the church as the body of Christ which includes all of the redeemed of all the ages.
