**Martha's Kitchen Pig Cooker**

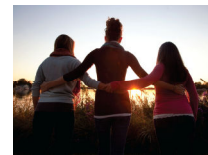

## A Season of Preparation

Each year Christ-Followers around the world prepare their hearts for Easter. This time of preparation is known as the Season of Lent. The Lenten Season is observed differently across various Christian denominations, but the truth of its purpose should be universal for all of us. That purpose is to prepare our hearts for the certainty of God's great love that is demonstrated in the precious, atoning death, burial and resurrection of His only Son, Jesus Christ. (John 3:16)

I was raised with a Moravian influence passed down to our family through my Grandmother, Sula Reid Hiatt. Many Easter Sunday mornings my family would wake before the sunrise and travel to Friedland Moravian Church. There we would hear the beautiful music of the Moravian brass ensemble echoing their melodies from one end of the cemetery to the other. This musical spectacular would conclude with the brilliance of sunrise over the chilly Easter morning flowered by the stunning presentation of Easter lilies all around. Even these thoughts bring deep emotions of thankfulness for Easter tradition and the remarkable truth that is ours in Jesus Christ.

The Season of Lent on the liturgical calendar begins on Ash Wednesday, (this year, March 1), and ends on Holy Saturday, (April 15), which is the day before Easter Sunday. These 46 days will be used by many as a time of deep introspection and soul-searching that will culminate in a renewal of commitment to the Lordship of Christ. How will you prepare your heart for the reality of God's precious, atoning love for you through the death, burial and resurrection of Christ?

Perhaps you have an annual tradition during the Season of Lent. Some find help and sacred meaning during Lent by abstaining from a physical pleasure that would be enjoyed during the rest of the year. This abstaining brings a constant PHYSICAL reminder of the SPIRITUAL need for a deeper love and devotion for Christ. That is a good thing!

Whatever your tradition, I pray that you will indeed come to a deeper understanding of our Heavenly Father's incredible love for you through Jesus Christ. I encourage you to put special events on your family calendar between now and Easter Sunday. Spend time together praying, reading scripture, considering the meaning of Easter's sacred symbols and talk about the great love of Jesus' demonstrated through His death, burial and resurrection.
