

Help Center Statistics

Last year the Federal Point Help Center fed 3,540 people living on Pleasure Island. The Help Center spent \$15,458.60 to buy food in addition to food donated by churches, individuals, food drives by Boy Scout Troop 210, Cub Scout Den 210, and the Knights of Columbus.

123 families received "Christmas baskets" (5-6 large grocery bags of food) at a total cost of \$65.89 per basket. Donations of staples from the churches, and many other financial gifts kept the cost down to the Help Center. Bam Ace Hardware once again donated the use of one of their storage lockers to store non-perishables before distribution for the holiday.

The Feinstein Foundation is a group that gives money to non-profit organizations based on the amount of provisions and money collected. Beginning March 1 through the end of April, all food will be counted by the Help Center volunteers in order to apply for financial consideration. The Help Center sincerely appreciated the help and generosity of our church family for the monetary gifts and food rations.

After clicking on the Login button in the upper right-hand corner, enter jimmy@fbccb.org in the Email Address box and then enter jimmy in the Password box. Under the Browse Media tab, click on the category you would like to view. Then click on the particular study you are interested in. To find out what print resources go along with the study, click on the orange button labeled Books, Workbooks, and Handouts. If you are interested in engaging in one of the studies, contact the pastor (458-5134) and he will add you as a user in the system. This is an excellent resource that offers unlimited topics of study.
