BUDGET/FINANCE UPDATE

(As of 9-30-15)

WHERE DO WE STAND

1. Monthly Budget \$24,027. YTD Budget \$216,247.
2. September 2015 general fund offerings: \$28,793. September offerings were over budget by 16.6%. We are behind \$27,940 for the YTD through September. This is an improvement over August. In order to meet budget, offerings must be \$33,341 per month for the remainder of 2015.
3. YTD Expenditures as of September 2015: Total Expenditures: \$215,756; YTD Budget \$216,247.
4. Year to Date general fund offerings: \$188,307. Year to date offerings are 87% of YTD budget, which is a significant improvement over August, which was at 80%.
5. Unrestricted cash on hand as of September 30, 2015 was \$65,664 (Compared to \$57,908 for August).
6. Designated fund offerings for September were \$980. YTD Designated offerings: \$29,200.
7. Account 1039 Martha's Kitchen has \$66,526 designated cash available.
8. Account 5115 CBFNC Mission Resource Plan (our church 10% tithe) paid for Sept. as well as our budgeted \$1,000 gift to the Help Center.
9. Account 5400 Electricity expense through September was \$8,982.
